The Associate in Arts degree in Music is a comprehensive course of study preparing the student to transfer to a four-year institution in music or a music related field, or to enter the music industry or a related field. RCSJ offers a wide variety of courses to satisfy the diverse interests and needs of its students. The program has a rich history of involvement in cultural and outreach activities within the community through the Concert Band, Jazz Band, and Chorus. Students who have completed the program will be able to:

- Explain, identify, and apply musical elements and techniques of music theory and aural theory.
- Demonstrate performing competence in their major area of study and in their particular ensemble performing areas.
- Recognize the historical basis of the development of musical forms and genres in its cultural context.
- Describe music technology in its various forms for teaching, composition, and scholarly pursuits.
- Locate, retrieve and critically evaluate information and information sources.
