<sup>6</sup>Students who intend to continue in the RCSJ 3+1 Inclusive Education program or transfer to Rowan University as an Inclusive Education major they should register for EDU 220. If students intend to transfer to Rowan University into either the Elementary Education or Early Childhood Education programs they should register for both EDU 215 & 216.

<sup>7</sup> Students intending to transfer to Rowan University as an Inclusive, Elementary or Early Childhood Education major (or remaining at RCSJ for the 3+1 program) MUST take PSY 213.
