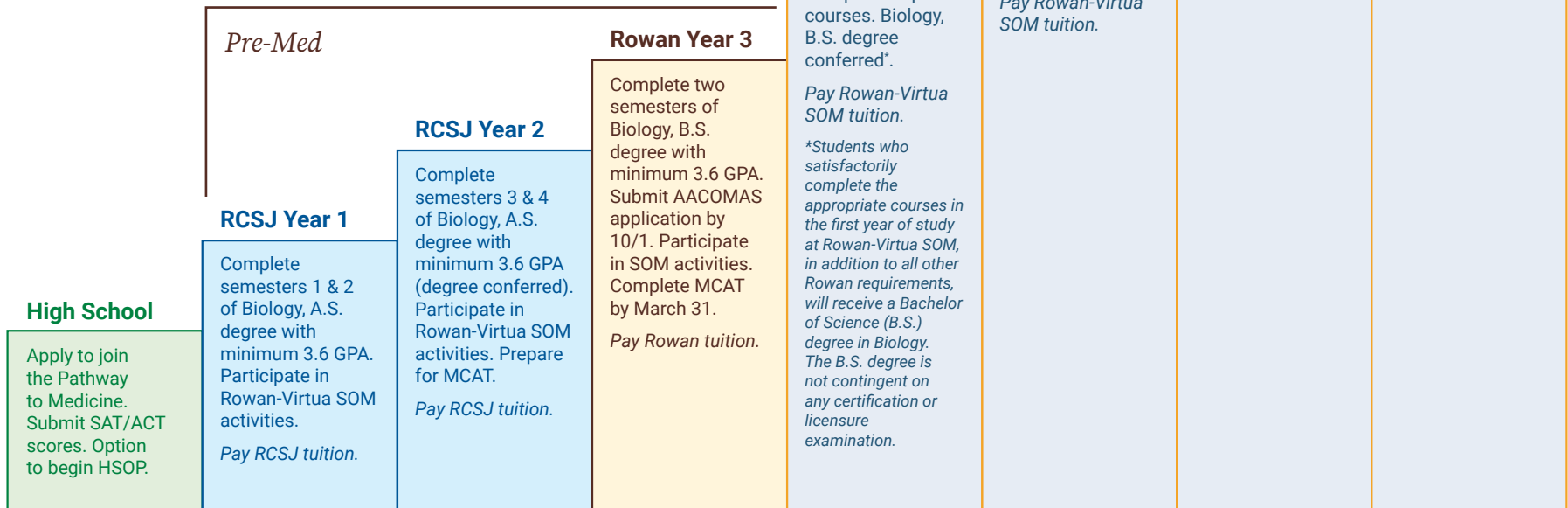
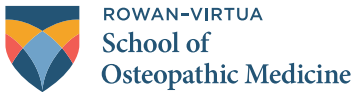


Pathway to Medicine

Pathway to Medicine

This new program guarantees early acceptance for five, high-achieving Gloucester and Cumberland County high school seniors each year in an accelerated, cost-saving pathway to a Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree from the Rowan-Virtua School of Osteopathic Medicine. Participants earn their A.S. in Biology from RCSJ and their B.S. in Biology from Rowan University in six semesters on their path to Rowan-Virtua SOM — with specialized career advising; peer mentoring; support from campus pre-med clubs and organizations; clinical, laboratory and career shadowing experiences; MCAT prep, and more to give Gloucester and Cumberland Counties’ top students the support they need to excel.



RCSJ with Rowan-Virtua SOM will join the American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine as we work collectively to improve representation in medicine.

RCSJ will offer a cohort program, Medical Prep Alliance, which will provide enhanced support including scholarships for underrepresented students.
