Terms of the Agreement

- 1. The program of study must be completed for seamless transfer in each major, as provided in the attachment.
- 2. The cumulative GPA required for automatic acceptance is 3.5. Students who do not meet this requirement but have a GPA of at least 3.0 will be given strong consideration.
- 3. An annual review will be held at the end of each school year, and form the basis of any changes to this agreement.
