## **GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES AND ACCUPLACER TESTING EXEMPTION**

High school students taking college courses at Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ) via HSOP are not bound by a selection of courses. It is suggested that the students take general education electives (listed below) as they are applicable to multiple degree programs and are highly transferrable.

The Accuplacer score(s) required to be achieved prior to course registration are listed next to each course. Students may submit the below standardized test scores to be awarded a testing exemption. RCSJ is also using multiple measures in lieu of Accuplacer testing by reviewing the student success in high school English III or IV and in Algebra I and II. Please submit a high school transcript for multiple measure review and approval.
