

## GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES AND ACCUPLACER TESTING EXEMPTION

High school students taking college courses at Rowan College of South Jersey (RCSJ) via HSOP are not bound by a selection of courses. It is suggested that the students take general education electives (listed below) as they are applicable to multiple degree programs and are highly transferrable.

The Accuplacer score(s) required to be achieved prior to course registration are listed next to each course. Students may submit the following standardized test scores to be awarded a testing exemption:
