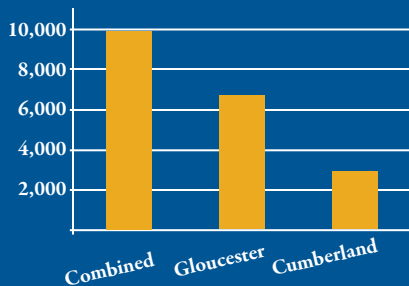

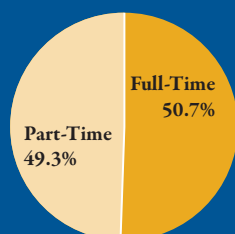


Rowan College of South Jersey Fall 2019 Enrollment by Attendance Status
