

### AGI Between \$0 and \$65,000

CCOG will pay the full, maximum award available at the college.

## AGI Between \$65,001 and \$80,000

CCOG will pay up to one-half of the maximum award available at the college. AGI Between \$80,001 and \$100,000

CCOG will pay up to one-third of the maximum award available at the college.

### AGI Between \$0 and \$65,000

GSG will pay the full, maximum award at the university.

## AGI Between \$65,001 and \$80,000

GSG students will pay no more than \$7,500 for tuition and fees at the university.

### AGI Between \$80,001 and \$100,000

GSG students will pay no more than \$10,000 for tuition and fees at the university.
