Follow checklist on <b><i>RCSJ.edu/FinancialAid</i></b></p> <p>↓</p> <p>Take the AccuPlacer (<i>if needed</i>) and complete any required remedial classes</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Meet with your academic advisor to develop course sequencing plan to apply to the Nursing Program</p>	<p>Look for new packet for Generic Nursing Program on Selective Admissions Website <b><i>RCSJ.edu/SelectiveAdmissions</i></b></p> <p>↓</p> <p>Take HSRT-AD for first time by August</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Retake AccuPlacer (<i>if needed</i>) for college level placement in all areas</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Meet with academic advisor to register for classes</p>	<p>Attend information session for Generic Nursing Program</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Do well in fall classes, and seek resources/supports if needed</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Meet with academic advisor for winter &amp; spring course selection</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Retake HSRT-AD if needed or preferred</p>	<p>Attend information session Generic Nursing Program, if not already completed</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Retake HSRT-AD if needed or preferred</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Order transcripts for portfolio, if applicable (<i>HS Transcript and/or college transcripts</i>)</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Print unofficial RCSJ transcript when fall grades post</p>	<p>Retake HSRT-AD if needed or preferred</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Attend information session for Generic Nursing Program, if not already completed</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Submit complete portfolio by posted deadline to be considered for admission</p> <p>↓</p> <p>Meet with academic advisor for summer &amp; fall course selection</p>

## Notes:

- All admissions requirements for the current application cycle are in the most recent Generic Nursing admissions packet.
- For an individualized plan to program application, students should meet with their academic advisor early in the application process. Some applicants may need to take remedial courses and other prerequisites before application.
- Applicants may only apply to **one** selective admissions program per application cycle.
- Registration for the HSRT-AD is in person at the Testing Center.
- Applicants only need to attend one information session per year for their Generic Nursing Program.
