## Helpful Hints for Portfolio Submission

*This guide is to assist you with some common questions about the actual submission of your portfolio. It acts as a supplement to the admissions packet and the information session for your program of choice – not a replacement.*

<b>What should I use to fill out Section III of my admissions packet?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Ballpoint Pen (black or blue ink)</li> <li>✓ Typed with handwritten signatures</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Pens with colorful ink</li> <li>x Pencil</li> <li>x Sharpie or other felt-tip pens</li> </ul>
<b>Where should I send the copies of my transcripts I'll use for my portfolio?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Mail to your home address</li> <li>✓ Pick up in-person at your college or high school</li> <li>✓ Do not open – keep in sealed envelopes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Send to campus admissions office – will not be added to your portfolio for you</li> <li>x <i>Printed copies of electronic transcripts (non-RCSJ) are prohibited</i></li> </ul>
<b>How should I print non-transcript documents I need to include in my portfolio? (Examples: proof of attendance email, proof of registration, unofficial RCSJ transcript)</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Print from a laptop or desktop computer</li> <li>✓ Use Word, Pages, or PDF format for required documents</li> <li>✓ All contents are easily readable</li> <li>✓ One-sided printing is preferable</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Screenshots taken from a phone, laptop, or tablet</li> <li>x Printing double-sided, if possible</li> </ul>
<b>How should I submit my portfolio?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ In-person at your designated campus's admissions office</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Sent via snail-mail</li> <li>x <i>Electronic submissions are prohibited</i></li> </ul>
<b>When should I submit my portfolio?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ After your final grades post to your transcript               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Ex: Fall and/or Winter for a Spring Deadline; Summer for a Fall deadline</li> </ul> </li> <li>✓ Any time during the posted submission window</li> <li>✓ After you've checked its contents multiple times and asked Selective Admissions for clarification (if needed) on required documents</li> <li>✓ When it is totally complete per the checklists in the admissions packet</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Rushing to “be first” – it will not give you an edge or boost in program admission</li> <li>x After posted deadline (it's firm)</li> <li>x If you do not meet one or more general or selective admissions requirements, please avoid submitting a portfolio for that year.</li> </ul>

# Verification of Instruction Method Examples

## Student Examples:

- **Student A:** Took both Anatomy I (Fall 2020, online) and Anatomy II (Spring 2021, in-person) at Widener University
  - Documents Needed: Proof of Registration (both courses), Course Syllabus (both courses), Faculty Statement (Only for Anatomy I)
- **Student B:** Took Anatomy I at RCSJ (Spring 2021) online and Anatomy II (Fall 2021) at Camden County College, in-person
  - Documents Needed: Proof of Registration for only Anatomy II at Camden County College
- **Student C:** Took both Anatomy I (Fall 2021, online) and Anatomy II (Spring 2022, hybrid) at RCSJ
  - Documents Needed: None – just RCSJ Unofficial Transcript in portfolio

- ✓ Meeting times clearly indicate what format class was taken (online, hybrid, in-person, etc.)
- ✓ Screenshot shows all information on one page – printed PDFs (not screenshots) are highly, highly encouraged

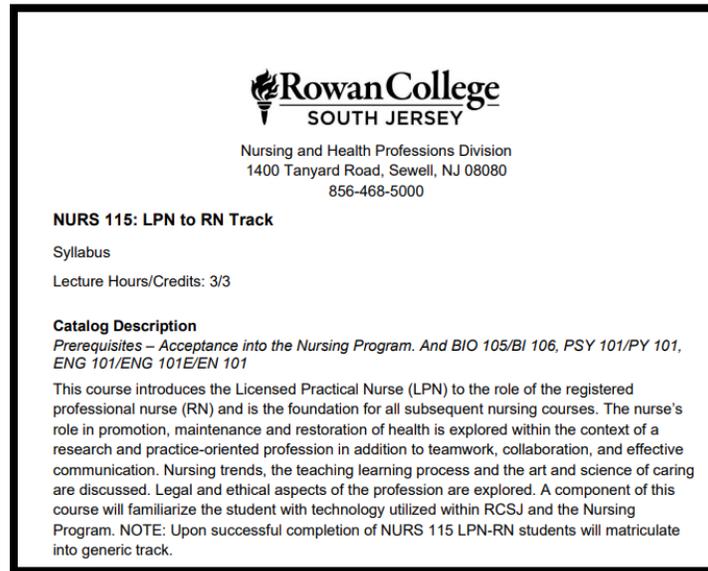

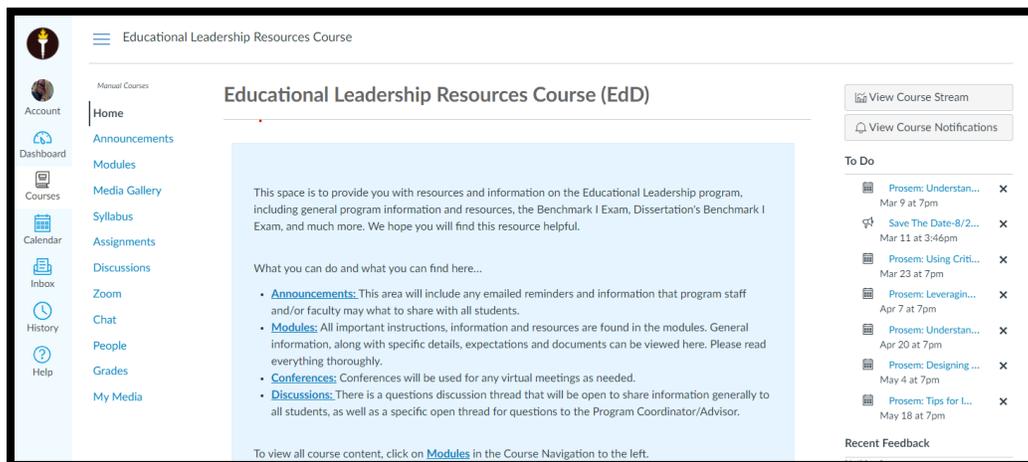

**Catalog Description**  
*Prerequisites – Acceptance into the Nursing Program. And BIO 105/BI 106, PSY 101/PY 101, ENG 101/ENG 101E/EN 101*

This course introduces the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) to the role of the registered professional nurse (RN) and is the foundation for all subsequent nursing courses. The nurse's role in promotion, maintenance and restoration of health is explored within the context of a research and practice-oriented profession in addition to teamwork, collaboration, and effective communication. Nursing trends, the teaching learning process and the art and science of caring are discussed. Legal and ethical aspects of the profession are explored. A component of this course will familiarize the student with technology utilized within RCSJ and the Nursing Program. NOTE: Upon successful completion of NURS 115 LPN-RN students will matriculate into generic track.
