Glossary of Terms

Selective Admissions: Used to define programs that require applicants to meet additional admissions criteria beyond general admissions to the College.

Cohort: Class of students accepted to selective admissions programs. Selective admissions programs accept one (1) cohort per academic year to their programs.

Two-Step Application Process: Consists of general admissions application (Step 1) and preparation of a portfolio for student's program of choice (Step 2)

Portfolio: The specific application and supporting documentation for the applicant's selective admission program of choice. Accepted at certain points during the program's application cycle.

Application Cycle: Timeframe in which prospective applicants can prepare a portfolio for their program of interest.

- ✓ Spring Application Cycle: July March
- ✓ Fall Application Cycle: March October/November
- ✓ Summer Application Cycle: January June

Verification of Instruction Method: Documents to determine the format and delivery of Anatomy & Physiology course (ex. face-to-face, hybrid, HyFlex, online, Live OnLine). Only required for A&P courses taken at another college or university.

General Admissions Completion Form: Form used to verify the applicant completed their General Admissions application to the College, including the general admissions application, submission of high school transcript, and demonstrated college-level placement in reading, writing, and math

Ranking Requirement: Components of portfolio that contribute to how an applicant is ranked against all other eligible applicants. Usually consists of standardized exam scores and academic components (science and/or math courses, GPA, etc.)

Information Session: Zoom webinars designed to introduce a prospective applicant to the twostep application process and their program of choice. Held monthly through respective program application cycle.

Accepted: A category of admission decision. The applicant met all admissions requirements and was offered admission to their program of choice.

Denied: A category of admission decision. The applicant met or exceeded all admissions requirements, but there was not space available for the applicant in the program.

Incomplete: A category of admission decision. The applicant submitted a portfolio either missing required documents or did not meet one or more of the specified admissions requirements. Not eligible for admission to program of choice.
