Associate in Science (A.S.) – Transfer

The program prepares students for entry-level employment in the field of social work as well as transfer into baccalaureate social work with an emphasis on healthcare leading to mid-level social work positions leading to case management and intake, community organization and program management, and child and family social work. Transferring to a master's in healthcare social work would be the primary goal. The flexibility offered by this program allows for entrance directly into the workforce or transfer to a B.S. in Social Work.

- Students will identify & assess the need of an individual or group; helping people obtain resources;
