RESOLUTION OF THE ROWAN COLLEGE AT GLOUCESTER COUNTY BOARD OF TRUSTEES AUTHORIZING A JOINTURE AGREEMENT BY AND AMONG THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF ROWAN COLLEGE AT GLOUCESTER COUNTY AND THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, AND AUTHORIZING OFFICERS OF ROWAN COLLEGE AT GLOUCESTER COUNTY TO TAKE ALL OTHER ACTIONS DEEMED NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE IN CONNECTION WITH THE SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (hereinafter the "Board") of Rowan College at Gloucester County (hereinafter the "College"), a body corporate in the State of New Jersey, is authorized to enter into contracts and agreements under and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland County College Board of Trustees ("Cumberland College") on April 19, 2018 adopted a resolution authorizing the exploration of a potential joinder of Cumberland College with the College; and

WHEREAS, the College, after consultation with members of The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Gloucester "Gloucester County", desires to offer to The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Cumberland ("Cumberland County") the ability to enter into a Jointure Agreement (a form of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A") and join in the operation of the College, pursuant to the authority of N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-24;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Rowan College at Gloucester County as follows:

- 1. The Board hereby authorizes, approves and consents to the execution of the Jointure Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", upon the approval of the Jointure Agreement by Gloucester County, the acceptance of the Jointure Agreement by Cumberland County and further authorizes the Chairperson of the Board, the Secretary of the Board, the President of the College, the Vice President and COO of the College, and any other representative of the Board hereafter duly authorized by the Board in writing (the "Authorized Officers" and each an "Authorized Officer") to determine all matters and authorize all necessary actions in connection therewith.
- 2. All resolutions, orders and other actions of the College in conflict with the provisions of this resolution to the extent of such conflict are hereby superseded, repealed or revoked.
- 3. All actions heretofore taken and documents prepared or executed by or on behalf of the College by its officials and by the College's professional advisors, in connection with the Jointure Agreement, or any other action in connection with or related to the same, are hereby ratified, confirmed, approved and adopted.

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH XEROX CORPORATION BASED ON STATE CONTRACT 072735900 PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.9a

WHEREAS, Rowan College at Gloucester County, pursuant to 18A:64A-25.9a, may by resolution and without advertising for bids, may purchase any materials, supplies, goods, services or equipment entered into under the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program for any State contracts entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, Rowan College at Gloucester County has the need for a high speed commercial copier; and

WHEREAS, Rowan College at Gloucester County intends to enter into contracts with the State Contract for Xerox Corporation through this resolution and properly executed contracts, which shall be subject to all the conditions applicable to the current State Contracts; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract will be for five (5) years commencing July 1, 2018 at an annual cost of \$36,346.44; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer for the College has certified that funds are available for this purchase; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Rowan College at Gloucester County hereby authorizes and directs the Purchasing Officer to obtain the commercial copier from the approved New Jersey State Contract Vendor Xerox Corporation, pursuant to all conditions of the individual State Contracts at an annual cost of \$36,346.44.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR AN INTERNET SERVICES PROVIDER

(Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 – Non-Fair and Open Process)

WHEREAS, Rowan College at Gloucester County is in need of a company to provide Internet Services; and

WHEREAS, County Contract Law (18A:64A-25.3) does not require public advertising if the purchases do not exceed \$35,300; and

WHEREAS, the College solicited quotes for an internet services provider; and

WHEREAS, the Vice President and Chief Operating Officer has determined that the total value of contract will exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Unit Pay to Play Law, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, *et seq* provides that when the values of a contract with a vendor exceeds \$17,500, that vendor is subject to the Pay-to-Play law; and

WHEREAS, Comcast Telecommunications Company has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that neither Comcast Telecommunications Company nor anyone with an interest in it has, during the one year period preceding the award of the contract made a reportable campaign contribution (as defined by N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, et seq.) to any County committee of a political party in the County of Gloucester if a member of that political party is serving in an elective public office of the County of Gloucester at the time that the contract is awarded, or to any candidate committee of any person serving in an elective public office of the County of Gloucester when the contract is awarded, and that the contract will prohibit from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Vice President and Chief Operating Officer certifies the funds are available; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Rowan College at Gloucester County on the 25th day of May 2018 that the President or his designee are authorized to enter into contracts with Comcast Telecommunications Company for \$26,400.00 for Internet Services.

BEGINNING JULY 1, 2018 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$277,430.

The program services must integrated training into the English literacy program emphasizing contextualized instruction on the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, civic participation, and career pathways.
