






How to Complete your "To Do List" on NJFAMS


1. Go to nifams.hesaa.org



2. Log into your NJFAMS account. If you have not created an NJFAMS account, click "Create a Student Login".

Note: If you have made to many failed login attempts, you may be locked out of your NJFAMS account. If you are locked out, please contact HESAA at 609-584-4480 (options 1, 2, 3) or at client services@hesaa.org





3. Once you have logged into your student NJFAMS home page, you can select what you would like to view.

Click on the "click here" link to answer the NJ Additional Questions. Dependent students are required to answer the additional questions with both parent and student information. You will need student/parent's 1040 tax return(s), unemployment benefits, and/or social security benefit information for the required year.

Note: Do not leave any blank answers, if the question does not apply to you enter 0 as the amount.

5. After you submit your NJ additional questions, you should receive an email from HESAA informing you if you are Eligible, Not Eligible, or Additional Information Required.
